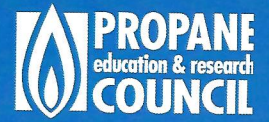


# Become a PERC CEU Qualified Instructor

One of PERC's goals has always been to provide effective, high-quality training to the people working in our industry. We're pleased to announce PERC has been named an accredited provider by the International Accreditors for Continuing Education and Training (IACET). A key advantage of this accreditation is knowing that with IACET certification, Learning Paths training is held to a high, verifiable standard. This also allows PERC to issue IACET continuing education units (CEUs) for instructor-led Learning Paths training.

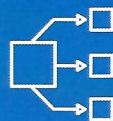
#### Learning Paths will benefit employees in multiple ways.
